Fr. Christ writes....

LORD, THAT I MAY SEE

Bartimaeus is a a man of faith. He approaches Jesus and calls on him as 'Son of David'. Bartimaeus could only call Jesus that from deep within his heart of faith. The people scold him, who does he think he is, a sinner, calling on Jesus like that. Yet he persists. He calls out in faith and his sight is restored.

With new vision Bartimaues chooses what disciples are invited to do, to follow Jesus. His physical healing also means a spiritual healing. It was his faith that saved him. Bartimaues is given his sight and we in Baptism have been given the sight of faith.



Jesus asks of us what do we want him to do? It can like Bartimaues, only be answered in faith. A faith that teaches us that we are blest, cared for and loved and are also invited to be disciples. That means growing closer to Jesus and following him.

But following Jesus means living with the eyes of faith and having our own blindness removed. That's the challenge. Because it means seeing everyone through the eyes of the faith of Jesus. Responding to those in need, reaching out, rejecting prejudice, speaking out against injustice. In other words being people who live our faith in practice.




