MESSENGERS WITH A STORY TO TELL

We live in an age where everything is known immediately. Social Media and the Internet now appear to be the fastest way of communicating with others. Snapchat, facebook and other social media sites allow people to put their entire lives on display. With a simple word search I can tap into anything about history or the world today within seconds.

In Jesus' time the spoken word was the way of communicating. They would have looked to the ancient scrolls to remember what God had done for them throughout their history. They kept their traditions and teachings alive by telling the story when they came together. Jesus reminds them of this as he speaks to them and frequently uses stories or parables to teach them.

In our world today, talking about religion is not encouraged, we are too embarrassed or afraid of what reaction we might get, if we do speak. Yet, in baptism, we are part of the story of faith, we are called also to be messengers, who keep the story of faith alive and pass it on to others.

February 14th Feast Day of St. Valentine

Patron Saint of: Love, marriages, engagements, young people, greetings, travellers, etc Saint Valentine was a Catholic priest who had also worked as a doctor. He lived in Italy during the third century AD and served as a priest in Rome. Historians don't know much about Valentine's early life, they pick up his story after he began working as a priest. Valentine became famous for marrying couples who were in love but couldn't get legally married in Rome during the reign of Emperor Claudius II, who outlawed weddings. When Emperor Claudius discovered that Valentine was performing weddings, he sent Valentine to jail.

The most famous miracle attributed to *Saint Valentine* involved a note he sent to a young blind girl named Julia who Valentine had befriended.

Shortly before he was martyred for his faith in Jesus Christ. Valentine wrote Julia a farewell note. Believers say that God miraculously cured Julia of her blindness so that she could personally read Valentine's note, rather than just have someone else read it to her. Valentine signed Julia's note "From your Valentine," and that loving note, combined with the memory of Valentine's support of engaged and married couples in his work as a priest, led to the tradition of sending loving messages on his feast day, Valentine's Day. Throughout the years since Valentine died, people have prayed for him to intercede for them before God in heaven about their romantic lives.
