# **Season of Advent**

In the church calendar, the four weeks before Christmas are known as Advent: a time of waiting and preparation. This Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent and you will notice the *Advent Wreath* in the church.

Sometimes in the hustle and bustle of the weeks leading up to Christmas it is easy to lose sight of what we are preparing for. As you get ready at this special time of the year, perhaps you and your family will make a conscious effort to be more aware of the true meaning of the celebration of Christmas - the birth of the Christ Child.

We can use this time to make spiritual preparation for Christmas.

The custom of the Advent Wreath is an excellent way for families to keep the real meaning of Christmas in perspective.

The Advent Wreath consists of a circle of evergreens and four candles.

The **circular shape** symbolises God's love for us, a love that has no beginning or end. **The evergreens** represent the continuing and everlasting life that comes from God through Jesus. As we light the candles each week we are made aware of our journey through this season from Advent to Christmas.

The four candles (three purple and a pink/rose colour) mark four weeks of Advent and point to Jesus as the light of the world. The purple candles show that Advent is a time of ADVEN waiting and preparation.

The **pink/rose candle lit** on the third week (Gaudete Sunday) reminds us we can rejoice as we draw near to Christmas.

An *Advent Wreath* in the home can be a wonderful opportunity for family prayer.

As we light our first candle this week we pray for God's blessing of the Advent wreath, our homes and each of us. Amen.

# The Advent Wreath

Most churches and families have an Advent Wreath. The custom wasn't always an Irish one. Wreaths were popular in Germany, Austria and Northern Europe. As people began to travel to these countries they saw the attractive wreaths and brought the idea home.

This week end we have one in each of our three Churches as this Sunday **December 1st** is the First Sunday of Advent. The wreath is a symbol of what Advent means.

So Advent is a time for us to prepare to receive Jesus into our hearts, our lives, our homes and our parish.

We need to **invite** Him. A very short traditional prayer for Advent is simply

#### "COME LORD JESUS"

We can say this at any time, travelling, in the house or when we pass a Church or Grotto. Having the Advent Wreath in the house the prayer could be said with children round the wreath, maybe at bedtime or before a meal. Remember when we invite Jesus into our lives He will never come empty handed. He will come to you with some special gift **or** blessing, something He knows you need. But you have to be **READY** and **WAITING**. I

Advent Week 1:- Hope

As we light this first candle of the Advent wreath together, Lord, grant us hope. As trees loose leaves and temperatures drop, we feel that the new life of Spring is far away.

May the Advent candlelight shine like our commitment to one another, that we can find wisdom and strength in reaching out and holding one another's hope. Like Mary and Joseph on the journey to Bethlehem, may we remain hope-filled through all of the challenges set before us on the way. 'I wait for the Lord, my whole being waits, and in his word I put my hope.' (Psalm 130:5)

**Hope** is faith holding out its hand in the dark.
