Ballinhassig Parish Pastoral Council

Ballinhassig P.P.C. met on May 13th 2025 and discussed the current situation regarding our Family of Parishes (F.O.P), which includes: Ballinhassig, Kinsale, Clontead (Riverstick and Belgooly) and Courcey's (Ballinspittle and Ballinadee)

Fr. Danny and representatives from Ballinhassig P.C.C., Finance Committee and sacristans recently attended three F.O.P meetings in Kinsale, along with representatives from the other three parishes. These meetings were organised by the Diocesan Office of Mission and Ministry and the themes discussed were Baptism, Eucharist and a review of the F.O.P. structure. While there was a lot of input, there was very little time for practical planning and discussion.

With Diocesan changes expected in June, it is unclear what impact any changes may have on Ballinhassig and our F.O.P. The F.O.P. structure enables priests to cover for each other in the event of a priest being unavailable, due to illness or holidays. Mass times across the four Parishes are arranged to make it possible for all Masses to be covered in the absence of one priest. Over the past two years, weekend Masses in each of the other three parishes were reduced to two Masses, while Ballinhassig retained three Masses. Depending on the impact of Diocesan changes, it is envisaged that Ballinhassig may have to reduce its weekend Masses and a rota system may have to be introduced. Any changes to the current Mass rota will be made in consultation with parishioners.


