#### **Rosminians Mission Appeal**



## Jesus in Everyday Life

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of the *Ascension of the Lord and is also World Communications Day*. Ascension Day is the 40th Day Of Easter. It commemorates Jesus Christ's return to Heaven after His Ressurection.



We are lucky to have the Gospels and the New Testament which remember some of the things Jesus did and said. Without them we would be very much in the dark.

But there are other books where the signs of Jesus are written, which are the books of everyone's life. You and I are the signs of Jesus.
