

I'm wondering what Christmas in Heaven is like As I grieve alone and pray, Longing for one who has gone before To spend Christmas in Heaven today.


And in my dreams, I wander far From the scenes and sounds of earth 'Till I catch the strains of the Heavenly choir As they sing of the Christ Child's birth.


