## Lord, We thank You

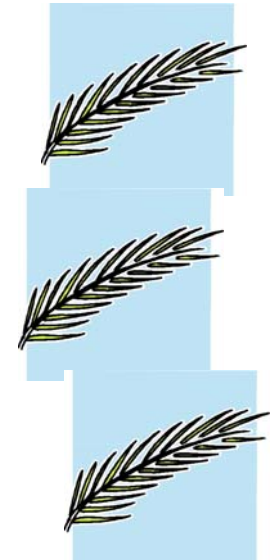
*Lord, you love us all,
