Mothering Sunday

History of Mothers day in Ireland?

The history of celebrating *Mothering Sunday or Mothers Day* in Ireland can be traced to the medieval practice where children from poor families were sent to work as domestic servants and apprentices to work with the rich. Once in the year in

the middle of Lent the children were given a day off to visit their *Mother Church* and worship the Virgin Mary. After visiting the Mother Church or Cathedral of their home town these children visited their mothers and presented them with flowers they picked along the way. Some girls baked a special Mothering Cake on the day. Patterns of living changed after the Industrial Revolution and Mothering Sunday celebrations almost lapsed. The custom was revived after World War 11. We now celebrate Mothers Day on the fourth Sunday of Lent. On this day people present their mothers with cards.

Teenager Summer Camp


