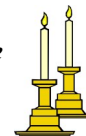

**Ballinhassig Parish Assembly along with Fr. Kieron** invite you to the **Parish Walk** on this Sunday **June 9th**, leaving the **Marian Hall at 2.30pm**.



Enjoy an afternoon of **FAITH, FRIENDSHIP & FUN**. The celebration of this event is special at this time as we celebrate the **YEAR OF FAITH**.
