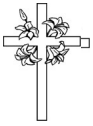


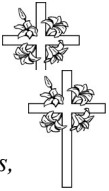

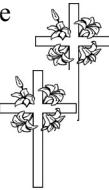

The Annual Parish Mass for the Bereaved will be held in **Ballyheada Church** on **Tuesday November 19th at 7.30pm.** All welcome.

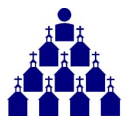
On this Sunday when we gather for prayers in the cemeteries of the parish, you may like to reflect on the following:-
