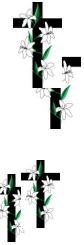

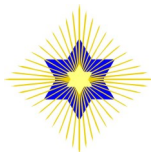

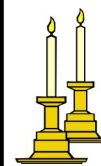
Dawn Mass - Parish

We ask this in the name of the God who loves us, the risen Jesus

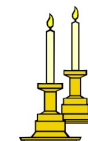
who gave his life that we might have new life
