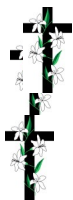

Mary O'Halloran submits...

Rosary Sunday October 5th

Rosary Sunday will be celebrated in parishes on **Sunday October 5th, 2014**, which is also the **Day for Life 2014**. It is the Sunday closest to the *feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7th)* and it coincides with the *60th anniversary of the Rosary Rally of Father Peyton*, as well as the **Marian Year of 1954.**



Rosary Sunday is an *invitation to people in parishes, in homes, in religious orders to pray the Rosary for the intention of the Family*, linking with Pope Francis and those gathered in *Rome for the Synod on the Family*.

The once common tradition of the family Rosary links very well with the theme of the Synod on the Family which takes place from October 5th – 19th. The Rosary from the Latin word *rosarium*, meaning 'Crown of Roses' is a form of prayer. It is divided into four parts, each having five mysteries: It is customary to begin by offering one Our Father, three Hail Mary's and a Glory Be to the Father for the intentions of the Holy Father. Each decade is **one Our Father, ten Hail Marys and Glory Be** to the Father. It is a difficult prayer to concentrate on and pray. This month of October we encourage you as a family to **begin by saying just one decade** or more. On October 13th, 1917 *Our Lady of Fatima* told the children, **"I am the Lady of the Rosary"**

- 4th The Transfiguration
- 5th The Institution of the Eucharist

The Glorious Mysteries

- 1st The Resurrection

 - 3rd The Descent of the Holy Spirit
 - 4th The Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven
 - 5th The Crowning of Our Lady as Queen of Heaven.
