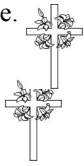

Holy Souls Novena, the visits to the
graveyards are good but they make
it impossible for people to avoid
being revisited by the
pain caused by the
death of a loved one.

sad, sudden and un-
timely deaths this
year and in the past few years.
Consequently we have many pa-
rishioners for whom November is a
very sad and lonely month.

The thought of facing Christmas
without the departed loved one
always brings enormous sadness in
need of some ray of hope to dispel
the darkness of grief. Conscious of
this, the *Parish Assembly once
again* have organised the **Annual
Mass for the Bereaved.**

**Special Mass on Monday November 17th at
7.30pm in Goggins Hill Church.** It is hoped
this Special Mass will bring a message of hope,
comfort and consolation to all who live with the
pain of loss, especially the death of a
loved one, separation, divorce, loss of
employment, financial security, health
and any other loss which we may en-
dure as individuals.

**As part of the ceremony everybody will be
invited to bring a lighted candle, available at
the door, to the altar on entering the church.**
These individual candles will then symbolise a
community of hope with all candles then lighting
as one. Everybody welcome, we are conscious
that we may not be aware of all parishioners who
suffered bereavements of family members who
resided outside the parish. The night, however,
is not only for those bereaved in the past twelve
months, it is a night for remembering and pray-
ing for all who are grieving. There is a great
tradition of support and understanding in our
parish at times of bereavement.

Mass on Monday 17th will be
another opportunity to offer sym-
pathy, and support through being
present and praying with our
bereaved families, neighbours
and friends.

All welcome, invite your family and friends from
outside the parish to join you on the night.
