Cork's Eucharistic Procession

As you will be aware, the Eucharistic Procession is a significant part of Cork's religious heritage. Cork's Eucharistic Procession is now in its 90th year. It commenced in 1926, when a group of



businessmen in the city approached the Bishop, Daniel Coholan, with a view to having a Eucharistic Procession in the City to mark the Feast of Corpus Christi. It was hoped that such an event might heal the division and bitterness in civil society at the time. Remarkably, since then, the Procession has not just survived but has become a feature of Catholic life in Cork.

Our faith is not something we celebrate behind closed doors, it is something that is meant to affect our daily lives. We should seek opportunities to celebrate our faith in public and give witness to the faith that has been given to us.

Once again this year it is planned to broadcast the entire Daunt's Square Ceremony live on **Cork Community Television** and **www.corkcity.ie/tv from 2.45pm.**
