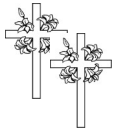

Fr. Christy writes...

TOUGH TIMES FOR CHRISTIANS IN THE MIDDLE EAST

If you travel to the top of the Mount Tabor in lower Galilee, you will arrive at a most beautiful Church. It is the site of the Transfiguration. The church was vandalised and desecrated. According to **The Jerusalem Post**, "the robbers stole chalices, looted the donation box and damaged icons. Unlike other Christian sites in Israel that have been attacked, no graffiti was painted." **Wadie Abunassar**, a spokesman for bishops in the Holy Land, also said that Communion bread was thrown on the ground.

Yet again, this past week has been a difficult one for Christians. Christians are in a minority, where the Hebrew Faith (Jews) and Muslim Faith dominate. Over the years there has been many attempts to reach out to each other and the Church, has always had to be careful to not be particularly associated with one side or the other.

In Syria, they live under constant threat of attack, their places of worship vandalised or destroyed and their lives in danger. The people of Syria have been almost bombed off the face of the earth. As a people, we have, in our own painful history, endured the oppression of our faith. Many feel in the secular society that we live in, all religion is being undermined.



Pope Francis has asked that we especially pray for the people of Syria this weekend, and of course we will, the text of the prayer is on page two. Let us also devote ourselves to ensuring, that we in our own place and time, always treat others with the respect they deserve, regardless of race, colour or religious belief.

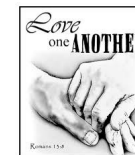


Remembering our Loved Ones
