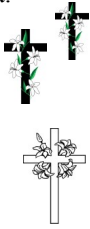

## Christ the King of Mercy

This weekend Pope Francis closes the Year of Mercy. It was a time for us to meet the compassion and Mercy of the Lord in a personal way. It was also a time to reflect on how we ourselves can be agents of the same mercy.

We also close our Liturgical Year and we focus on Christ the King. Only he wasn't a King with palaces and wealth, worldly power and control. His throne was a cross, his crown not of pure gold and precious jewels but of rough and sharp thorns.

His Kingdom and his Kingship is not like others, as the world sees things. It is about truth and honesty, about compassion and mercy about healing and forgiveness, about goodness and generosity and about service. Our preface this weekend puts it beautifully: "an eternal kingdom, a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace.

We are invited this weekend to renew our faith and loyalty to our King: To choose him and his ways. To offer our love and devoted service to his cause. To make our commitment to him from our heart.

We have the opportunity to begin to make his kingdom come. By our own commitment, and moved by his loving mercy and compassion, to create a little bit of heaven of earth.
