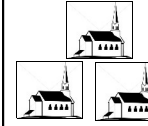

writes...

BE A BLESSING TO ALL

'Listen, Israel: The Lord our God is the one Lord. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength. Let these words I urge on you today be written on your heart.' These words are inserted into a special vessel and are placed in a carved niche of the doorposts of the houses of people of the Hebrew Faith. They take these words very seriously and touch their fingers to their lips and put their fingers on it as they enter and leave the house as a sign of respect and reverence for these precious, holy words of God.

Jesus as a practicing Hebrew took these words to a new level when he added and 'you must love your neighbour as yourself.' For us we are meant to take them literally. It's the same meaning of the Beatitudes, which we heard on Thursday for the Feast of All Saints.



We are all called to be saints and that means putting all these words into practice by thinking beyond ourselves and looking towards others. Because when we do so, we are not just respecting the dignity of every person but in the very act of doing it we also show love and respect for God. *May we actively strive to be a source of blessing to others.*

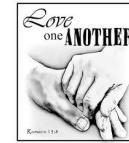
