Bishop Fintan Gavin of the *Diocese of Cork & Ross* will travel with twenty young people (18-30 years) from around the Diocese to **World Youth Day 2023 in Lisbon.** (July 31st to August 7th) Two to four million young people from around the world are expected to attend and pray with Pope Francis.

February 14th Feast Day of St. Valentine

Saint Valentine was a Catholic priest who had also worked as a doctor. He lived in Italy during the third century AD and served as a priest in Rome. Historians don't know much about *Valentine's* early life, they pick up his story after he began working as a priest. Valentine became famous for marrying couples who were in love but couldn't get legally married in Rome during the reign of Emperor Claudius II, who outlawed **weddings**. When Emperor Claudius discovered that Valentine was performing weddings, he sent Valentine to jail. The most famous miracle attributed to *Saint Valentine* involved a note he sent to a young blind girl named Julia who he had befriended. Shortly before he was martyred for his faith in Jesus Christ, *Valentine* wrote Julia a farewell note. Believers say that God miraculously cured Julia of her blindness so that she could personally read Valentine's note, rather than just have someone else read it to her.
