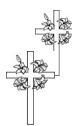

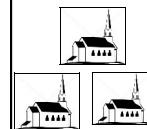

Prayer after a difficult Day

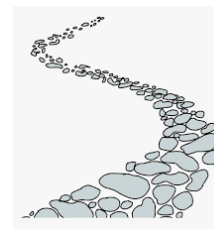
We can pray in many different ways – in silence,
