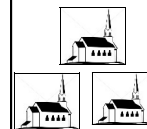

Ballygarvan Church Volunteer Groups

As there were no applicants for sacristan in Ballygarvan church, volunteers are urgently needed to help with regard to the church.

It is proposed to form two volunteer groups:

One group for helping in the sacristy for Sunday morning Mass, Friday morning Mass, funerals, christenings and weddings. Active retired people who can drive or live within walking distance of the church would be best suited to volunteer for this group because it involves daytime commitments.
